

Completing the credit policy template

If your institution awards credit to students for Cambridge International AS & A Level exams, please complete and upload the credit policy template. Below are guidelines for entering data into the template.

Credit Subject: Enter the Cambridge International subject or syllabus name, e.g. Biology.

This field is limited to 40 characters. For Mathematics subjects which have longer titles, please abbreviate as shown below:

- Maths (Pure, Mech, Prob & Stats)
- Maths (Pure, Prob & Stats)
- Further Maths (Pure, Mech, Prob & Stats)
- Further Maths (Pure, Prob & Stats)

Credit Syllabus Code: Enter the 4-digit syllabus code given to each subject by Cambridge International, e.g. 9093 for Cambridge International A Level English Language. Syllabus codes can be found in the course name drop down list and on our website.

Credit Qualification Level: Enter the qualification level of the credit subject, e.g. Cambridge International AS Level or Cambridge International A Level. If you offer different credit for AS and A Level, please list each qualification level separately.

Grade Minimum: Enter the minimum Cambridge International score, or grade, required for credit as letter grades, e.g. A, B, C, D or E. Please use lower case letters for AS Level grades and upper case letters for A Level grades, as shown in the grade chart below.

Course Name: Enter the university or college course name associated with the subject, e.g. ENC 1101, ENC 1102, ENC 1102, LIT 1000. There is a character limit of 40 characters for the course name field, including spaces.

Credit Hours Awarded: Enter the number of credit hours awarded, e.g. enter "5" for 5 hours.

Course Type: Do not edit. These columns are set to N as standard – please do not change this.

Credit Comments: Enter any additional information regarding individual subjects. This information will be displayed along with your credit table.
